






RDA Worldwide Growth

RDA Europe



- European plug-in to the Research Data Alliance
- Launch of RDA Europe 4.0 in March 2018
- Mandated to become the centrepiece for an EU Open Science Strategy
- Establishment of a network of national nodes to foster adoption of RDA outputs in the region
- Calls to expand the network via a cascading grant funding mechanism

DMP Common Standards WG



- Shortcomings of existing DMPs
 - manually completed, vague, not updated, ...
- Machine-actionable DMPs
 - living documents
 - · automate data management
 - collect information from systems
 - trigger actions in systems
- Goal: Define common data model for machine-actionable DMPs
 - · to model information from standard DMPs
 - NOT a template
 - NOT a questionnaire
 - · modular design
 - · core set of elements
 - · domain specific extensions
- 100+ members from around the world (DMP tool providers, funders, etc.)
- work: online, workshops, plenary meetings
- 18 months (Sep 2017 Apr 2019)

Research Data Alliance Austria fully supports the 26 October 2017 Declaration of the European Open Science Cloud.

Research Data Alliance Austria acts as a regional node of the Research Data Alliance (RDA), an international organization that serves as a professional connector for global activities dedicated to promoting and facilitating research data sharing. RDA Austria enables both national and transnational engagements, creating professional pathways to address data-related issues that are critical to both research community and the public at large. The primary goal of RDA Austria is to mittigate the wide range of technical, organizational, and cultural challenges that currently discourage open and effective sharing of publically funded research data assets.

RDA Austria organizes events and trainings that promote best practices in research data management, effectively providing an incubation space for the development of shared services and common standards, including policy development, data management planning, and infrastructure interoperability requirements. RDA Austria's initial Work Packages, to be undertaken in 2018, will directly address:

- 1) data citation, discovery, and reuse
- 2) GDPR and its impact on research data
- 3) research data management policies for industry partners and SMEs
- 4) machine-actionable data management plans
- 5) unique challenges concerning research data in the digital humanities

RDA Austria will specifically actively support the principles of the EOSC Declaration in the following areas: data culture, FAIR principles, data stewardship, skills, data management plans, technical implementations, standards, legal aspects and governance models.
